

We recently added elevated, distinct programming offered to the greater Bergen County community in a wide variety of disciplines including literature, Jewish studies, contemporary topics, music, and the arts, through The Henry & Elaine Kaufman Center for Jewish Living.

We are a warm, inclusive, and musical congregation made up of individuals and families from diverse backgrounds, ranging from traditionally religious to secular. Our lively multi-generational community remains anchored to its Jewish heritage while we seek to remain relevant and meaningful to current and future generations.
